
## Kyoto by the sea





Amanohashidate & Tango peninsula, 2-day package (from Kyoto)



What do you imagine when you hear "Kyoto"? Kiyomizu Temple, Kinkakuji Temple, souvenir shops crowded with tourists? But if you go to the north part of Kyoto prefecture you can experience completely different atmosphere. Tango peninsula, Amanohashidate and this area is called "Kyoto by the sea", where you can enjoy the superb view while watching the sea.

**DAY1:** Depart Kyoto Station to Amanohashidate Station by 7:32 limited express. Upon arrival, transfer to Amanohashidate by localbus, and take a cable car or a lift to Kasamatsu Park, where you can get a panoramic view of Amanohashidate from the observation. After that, visit worshiping spiritual spots such as Nariai-ji Temple and Moto-Ise-Konojinja Shrine. Next, take a local bus to Ine. In Ine town, there is a unique fisherman's houses called "Funaya" with a boat garage on the first floor and a residence on the second floor. Take a sightseeing boat and see the Funaya from the sea. When you return to Miyazu Station from Ine, board the complimentary shuttle bus to the hotel and check in at Hotel & Resorts Kyoto Miyazu. Relax with a hot spring and enjoy buffet dinner.

**DAY2:** After checking out, take the hotel's complimentary shuttle bus to Miyazu Station. From there, walk to Miyazu City Tourism Exchange Center, "Michi no Eki Kyoto Miyazu". Here you can rent a bicycle (please pay 500 yen on the spot) and enjoy a ride in the city. There are a lot of attractions such as the former Mikami Family Residence and the Catholic Miyazu Church. After enjoying cycling, return the bike and take a limited express from Miyazu Station to Kyoto Station. The tour disbands upon arrival at Kyoto Station.
