

North Tohoku [Akita, Iwate & Aomori]

Interact with local cuisine and Akita-inu. 3-day package (from Tokyo)



Visit the three prefectures of Iwate, Akita, and Aomori on the north side of Honshu. Let's go to an area full of attractions and experiences such as food culture, local festivals, and Akita dogs that are popular all over the world! *No guide or assistant service is included.

DAY1: Transfer from Tokyo Station to Ichinoseki Iwate Prefecture by Shinkansen and the local train. This area is famous for "mochi (rice cake) culture" from about 400 years ago. After enjoying "mochi" lunch at the local restaurant transfer to Hiraizumi by local train&bus, and visit Chusonji. A world heritage site, Don't miss the Golden Hall "konjikidou" decorated with gold and Raden. After the visit, transfer to Morioka by Shinkansen and check in to your hotel.

DAY2: From Morioka Station, take an express bus to Odate City, Akita Prefecture. After arriving, head to the tourist facility "Akita Inu no Sato" in front of Odate Station. In addition to Akita Inu Museum and Akita Inu related souvenirs, there may be a real "Akita inu" dog in the exhibition room. After that get on a local bus and visit the local cuisine of Akita, "Kiritanpo", at the "Cheerful Mother's restaurant" and experience lunch. Return to Odate Station by local bus. Then transfer to Aomori station by limited express train.

DAY3: Take a local bus and visit Sannai Maruyama ruins, a village of about 5,900-4,200 years ago. Then, visit Aomori Museum of Art next to the ruins. After returning Aomori station enjoy your lunch on own. "Nokke don" a rice bowl with various kinds of rawfish is the local specialty. After lunch the stalls are exhibited, you can visit the Nebuta House Wa Rasse, where you can experience the power of the "Nebuta Festival", and the Tourist Product Center. Return to Tokyo by the Shinkansen.
