

Traditional taste of Kyushu mountains

[NAGASAKI / MIYAZAKI] 3-day package (from Hakata)

Shimabara (Nagasaki Prefecture), where you can enjoy “Shimabara Tebebe Somen” utilizing the rich spring water, and Takachiho, where you can taste “Kagura cuisine”, which is served during the traditional dance of “Yokagura”, which is dedicated to the gods of Japanese mythology. Miyazaki Prefecture). Let's enjoy Kyushu's deep charm through two local dishes.

*No guide or assistant service is included.

DAY1: From Hakata Station, take a JR limited express train to Isahaya Station. Take the local train from Isahaya Station and get off at Shimabara Station. From Shimabara Station, change to a bus and go to "Somen Cuisine Mengui", a restaurant where you can eat hand-stretched somen. In addition to traditional Japanese seasonings, there are also dishes served with western sauce (on your own). After dinner, take a bus to Shimabara Port. From the port, take a ferry to Kumamoto. Take a bus from Kumamoto Station to the hotel and check in (Dinner is on your own.).

DAY2: Take a bus "Takachiho Limited Express" at Kumamoto-ekimae bus stop 1. Get off at Takachiho Bus Center. It takes about 8 minutes to walk from the bus center to the hotel. You can keep your luggage even before check-in. After having lunch, they have free time until evening. Recommended is the "Takachiho Gorge" which is about a 20 minute walk from the hotel. There is also a promenade where you can stroll while enjoying the nature. The "Manai Falls" that is said to be the symbol of Takachiho-kyo is a must-see. After dinner of "Kagura cuisine", they enjoyed "Yokagura" at Kaguraden of Takachiho-jinja Shrine.

DAY3: After checking out of the hotel, I go to the Takachiho Bus Center. Check your luggage at the "Machinaka Information Center" across from the bus center (300 yen per piece) and rent an electric assisted bicycle (300 yen per hour). The cycling destination is "Amanoiwatojinjya" and from there on foot "Amanoyasukawara". Both spots are related to the god "Amaterasu Omikami" who built Japan, and you can enjoy a solemn and mysterious atmosphere. In the evening, after returning the rental cycle, take the express bus "Gokase" from the Takachiho Bus Center and return to the Hakata Bus Terminal.
