

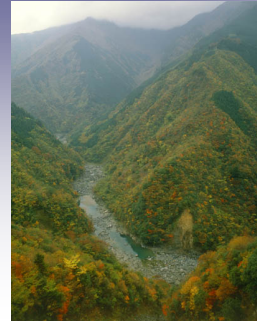
# Nishi-Awa District, Home of the Primitive Scenery of Japan
