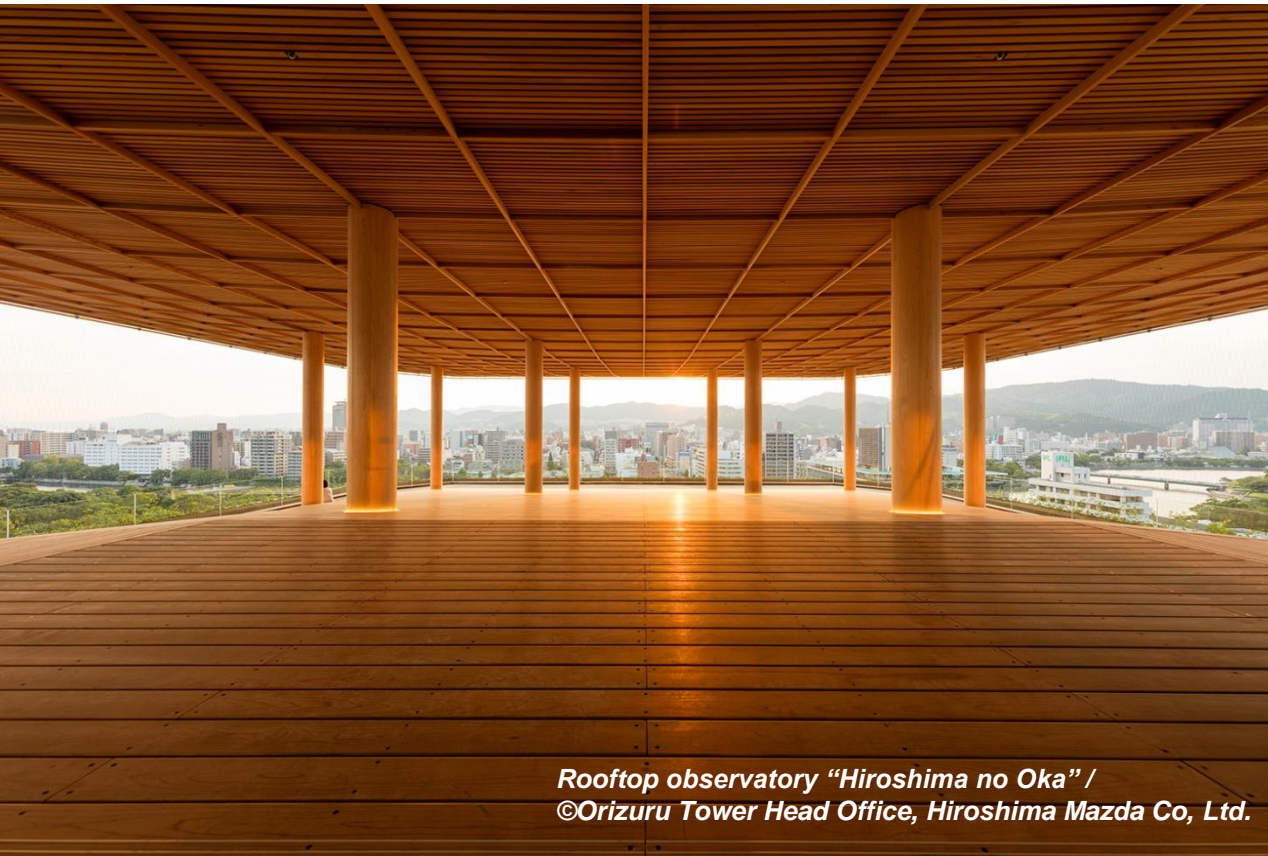


# Orizuru Tower / Hiroshima

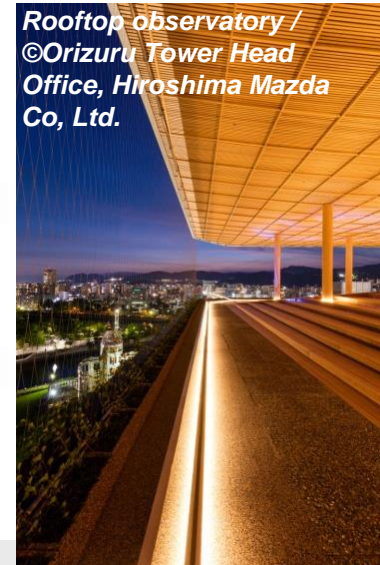
The Orizuru Tower was built as a new tourist attraction in Hiroshima. It stands to the east of the Hiroshima Peace Memorial World Heritage site, and its observatory offers a view of the Hiroshima Peace Memorial Park and the revived cityscape of Hiroshima, stretching even as far as the island of Miyajima. The observatory floors, located on the 12th and 13th floors, can be entirely reserved. The 13th floor is a wooden observatory deck surrounded with mesh, letting the wind blow through. We recommend using it as a cocktail venue.
